English

We will be learning to:

- Read, explore and compare different stories about King Arthur
- Design and describe our own castles
- Write about our own knights and their adventures / quests
- Read and evaluate instructions
- Write our own instructions for how to be a good King or Queen

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 4 digit number (1000's)
- Find 1000 more or less than a given number
- Order and compare numbers beyond 1000
- Round any number to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000
- Solve number and practical problems with increasingly large numbers
- Count backwards through zero to include negative numbers
- Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits using the formal written methods
- Measure and calculate the perimeter of different shapes
- Convert between different units of measures

Science

We will be learning to:

- Describe the basic parts and functions of the human digestive system
- Identify the different types of human teeth and their functions
- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey

We will be learning to:

- Understand what being happy means to Buddhists.
