Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be learning:

- Thinking about our class rules and how they can help us to keep safe.
- Understand that I am unique and this makes me special.
- Continue to develop sharing and turn taking skills.
- Learning a new song to begin to understand our feelings, happy, sad, scared, angry etc.

Communication and Language

We will be learning:

- Talking about things we can do now that we couldn't do when we were smaller.
- Practicing nursery rhymes and using our new voice recorder to listen to ourselves.
- Talking about our families and pets.
- Listening to stories and recalling characters and storylines – Alfie and Annie Rose stories.
- Using our language and communication skills within the home corner.

Physical Development

We will be learning:

- Continue to develop fine motor skills, through activities such as playdough, tweezer work, construction activities.
- Begin to write my name – independently, copying letters, tracing over letters.
- Looking at our five senses, things I can see, hear, touch, smell and taste.
- Catch, throw and kick a large ball.
- Understanding the importance of good hygiene after toileting and before eating

Understanding of the World

We will be learning:

- What did we look like as babies? Photo wall, can we guess who is who?
- Talk about different hair and eye colours, begin to notice how we are all different.
- Thinking about where we live, how our homes differ from each other and how they are the same.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning:

- Using different media and textures to create portraits of ourselves.
- Listening to different types of music and talking about our preferences.
- Creating movement to some of the music.
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Mathematical Development

We will be learning:

- Counting body parts, e.g. fingers, toes, eyes, ears, nose.
- Make a display for one of our working walls, depicting, 10 fingers, 2 eyes etc.
- Ordering pictures from baby to grandparent.
- 2D shapes, can we make a house, person, robot, using 2D shapes.
- Going on a shape spotting walk.

Literacy

We will be learning:

- Using our new mark making station in the garden.
- Exploring, chalk, pastels, crayons, felt tips, paints and stamper pens.
- Practicing writing our names using our name cards. Talking about our initial capital letter and how we follow this with small case letters.
- Thinking about rhyming words in stories, poems and songs.
