We will closely monitor its use during the assembly and be ready to remove a participant if we feel their actions are inappropriate. We only ask that 'extended participants' do not 'share/turn on' their video so the children are able to spot their friends easily.*

We have reviewed this week's school provision and, once again, have been delighted with how things have gone. As confidence in our community grows and more people are returning to work, we are seeing our pupil numbers in school grow so we will be creating a 7<sup>th</sup> 'Bubble' in two weeks' time.
