

Topic Title: Marvellous Medicine!

RE/PSHE

We will be working on our weekly Christian Values of Love, Honesty, Thankfulness, Forgiveness, Compassion and Tolerance. We will also be looking exploring stories that change people and looking at the Shabbat.

Geography

We will be looking at where different plants grow and where medicinal plants come from in the world. We will be also be looking at how weather patterns and climate can affect plant growth.

English

We will be looking at George's Marvellous Medicine as our class book. From this, we will be writing our own instructions to make marvellous medicine, diary entries in role and character descriptions. We will also be writing our own marvellous medicine stories! We will learn new vocabulary to help us to improve our writing. We will also use clues from the text when we are reading to help us make predictions.

Computing

We will be learning: We will be using the computers and iPads in cross curricular lessons. We will continue using scratch to practise programming.

History

We will be learning about important people within science and medicine.

We will look at Marie Curie, Mary Seacole, Edith Cavell and comparing Victorian and modern day hospitals.

Maths

We will be learning:

- Geometry and properties of shapes, including symmetry and position and direction
- Measurement- including length, capacity and time
- Word problems, which cover all number operations.

We will be learning: Following Charanga- singing a range of songs and learning some musical vocabulary. We will also be doing drumming on a Wednesday afternoon. In Art and D&T, we will be designing and improving our marvellous medicine packaging, among many other exciting projects.
