### English

We will be learning to:

- read and understand fairy tales and information texts
- hear and map stories, reports and recounts
- animate and tell stories, reports, recounts and poems (strong link to computing)
- write and share our writing, helping us to edit
- read aloud our own writing and present our ideas clearly to the class
- develop our spelling and phonic strategies

### Maths

We will be learning to:

- Count forwards and **backwards** in steps of 1, 2, 5 and 10, compare numbers
- Use Numicon and number lines to help us: add, subtract, multiply, divide and solve simple problems
- Learn number facts by heart - Learn Its 1/2/3/4
- find quarters of collections of objects
- explore and measure **time**

### Science

We will be learning to:

- explore and learn about materials- sorting and grouping materials, considering their use and how they can be changed, linked to literacy fairy tale theme
- observe seasonal changes, patterns in weather and how day length varies
- observe growth and experiment with plants e.g. beanstalks

### RE

We will be learning to:

- explore bible stories and stories from other religions about creation and caring for the world
- discuss the weekly collective worship themes

### History

We will be learning to:

- sequence some events and objects in chronological order
- begin to understand local events, and how people and places change
- sort artefacts into 'then and now'

### Computing

We will be learning to:

- use ipads for creating and recording e books,
- use the Internet and ICT safely
- write simple instructions for the Beebots to navigate around fairy tale grids
- use programs to draw and design

### PE

We will be learning to:

- balance and move in dance
- Year 1 Dance in assembly
- develop ball skills
- work as a team and develop team tactics
