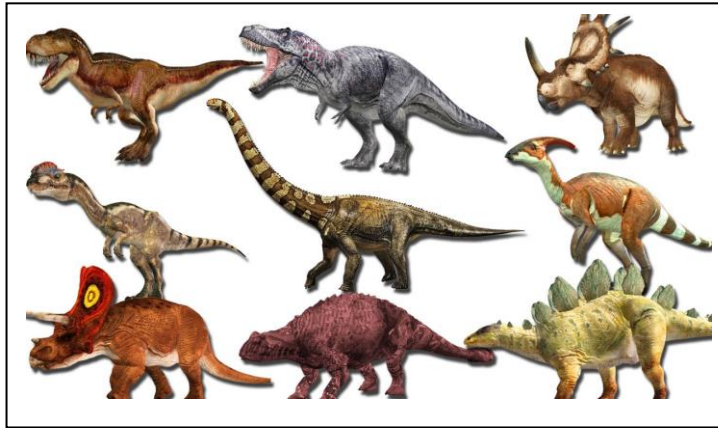


**Topic Title: Long, Long Ago**

**Class: Nursery Class**

**Term: 4**



### Mathematical Development

We will be learning:

- One to one touch Counting games with the different sized dinosaurs.
- Ordering games, missing number games, matching and counting games. Etc.
- Outdoor, play 'What's the time Mr Dinosaur'.
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### Communication and Language

We will be learning:

- Listening and attention game – placing dinosaur themed items on a tray, cover with a cloth and then take one away. Can the children say which one is missing?
- Learning dinosaur rhymes and songs.
- Finding dinosaur bones and eggs in the sand. Talking about what we have found.

### Literacy

We will be learning:

- Model writing simple dinosaur facts.
- Practice letter formation of phase 2 letters on decorative dinosaur writing frames.
- Tracing around dinosaur pictures for pencil control and follow the dinosaur maze games.
- Phonic games on a dinosaur theme.
- Making dinosaur booklets.
- Listening and recalling Harry and the dinosaur stories.

### Understanding of the World

We will be learning:

- Talk about extinction, what it means? Use non-fiction books and ICT to find out information about dinosaurs and how they lived.
- Make chocolate cornflake dinosaur nests, complete with mini chocolate dinosaur eggs, exploring the changes that take place when melting chocolate.
- Dinosaur Beebot games

### Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning:

- Create papier mache dinosaur eggs.
- Making marbled eggs using a salad dryer.
- Using the percussion instruments to make sound of different dinosaurs.
- Making salt dough fossils.

### Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be learning:

- \*Discuss story of Harry and the Dinosaurs and how Harry might feel when he loses his dinosaurs. Have you ever lost anything? What or who helped you to feel better?
- \* Frozen dinosaurs eggs using balloons, can the children work out how to rescue the baby dinosaurs.
- Dinosaur role play activities using masks.

### Physical Development

We will be learning:

- We will learn a dinosaur stomp game using different types of music and dinosaurs.
- Create a dinosaur swamp using gloop and other textures.
- Dinosaur dancing.
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
