English We will be learning to:

- Character and setting descriptions

Maths We will be learning to:

- Measure length using standard and non-standard units of measure
- Understand numbers up to 50
- Understand weight and mass
- Begin to measure time to the hour.

Science We will be learning to:

- Ask questions about the world around us
- Formulate investigations and use our scientific knowledge to conduct experiments.
- Predict, create and record experiments.

RE We will be learning to:

- Key question: Why was Jesus welcomed like a king or celebrity by the crowds on Palm Sunday?
- Explore and understand the Easter Story

Topic We will be learning to:

- Names parts of a Castle and their importance.
- Understand the different types of castle and their features.
- Name parts of a knights armour and its purpose.
