**English We will be learning to:**

- Create wanted posters for Pirates!
- Develop our reading comprehension skills by studying a text and answering questions.
- Describe a setting and a character

**Maths We will be learning to:**

- Rehearse our addition and subtraction skills to 20 by solving one step problems.
- Find ½ of a number, shape or quantity.
- Explore and identify values of coins.

**Science We will be learning to:**

- Identify and name animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- Identify and name animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

**RE We will be learning to:**

- Key question: Is Shabbat important to Jewish children?
- We will be looking at Shabbat, what is it, how it is celebrated and why it is important to Jewish people.

**Topic We will be learning to:**

- Name the oceans and begin to identify them on a map.
- Explore and name some famous pirates.
- Explore maps and geocaching to find local treasure!
