Understanding the World:

We will be learning:

- About different modes of transport and following the children's interests we will be looking in detail at chosen transport- how it works and how it has changed.
- Recapping road safety and how we can stay safe near the road.
- To create maps of the local area and use these in our play.
- Explore and talk about forces

RE: Our big question this term is: How do people celebrate? We will be looking at the New Year and how we celebrated it. We will also begin to look at Hinduism and how people in different religions celebrate.

PSED: We will be using Jigsaw to look at our Dreams and Goals. We will discuss how we can overcome challenges and what we can do to achieve our goals.

Communication and Language/Literacy: We will be learning to:

Predict texts- using the story 'The Train Ride' we will be continuing the patterns in the book to develop our own journey. We will also be looking at the key texts: Mrs Armitage-Queen of the Road and Grandpa's Surprise to create our own forms of transport. We will be creating lists, labels and captions to help us build our own transport which we can then label and display.

Terrific Transport!



This term our topic is Terrific Transport!
We will be looking a variety of different modes of transport and how they work and how they have changed over time. We will be creating our own transport and going on our own adventures based on the stories we will be sharing as a class.

Physical Development: We will be learning to:

- Move in different ways ensuring that we remain safe in the given space.
- Developing our balancing skills.
- Develop our fine motor skills through a variety of activities.

Maths: We will be learning to:

- Name 2d shapes and using them to create pictures.
- Rehearse subitising numbers up to 5.
- Number bonds to 5.
- Comparing mass and weight

Expressive Arts: We will be learning to:

- Explore different ways to make marks using tracks/transport in paint
- Creating different modes of transport out of junk modelling.
- Exploring different songs and rhythms based on transport including our favourite nursery rhymes such as wheels on the bus.
- Creating maps to enhance our role play.
- Develop our role play based on our own experiences of using public transport.
