


## Egyptians Year 3



### Weekly Home Learning

Please complete your 'proof-reading and correcting' task, record your **daily reading** in the diary, practise your **spellings** and **RockStars timetables**.

You can also complete one of the optional activities below:

#### English We will be learning to:

- Write an alternative ending
- Write a persuasive letter
- Develop our handwriting, spelling, punctuation and grammar
- Develop our reading skills

#### Maths We will be learning to:

- Compare, add and subtract mass
- Measure, compare, add and subtract capacity
- Measure and calculate perimeter
- Calculate and compare durations of time

#### Science We will be learning to:

- Understand that we need light to see and that darkness is the absence of light
- Explore what happens when light is reflected
- Explain how shadows are formed

#### History We will be learning to:

- Research artefacts from Ancient Egypt
- Explain the importance of the River Nile in Ancient Egypt
- Retell the key steps of the mummification process
- Read and understand how hieroglyphics were used

#### RE We will be learning to:

- Recall the main deities for Brahman
- Explore the Hindu belief that Brahman is in everything and can change and influence things but can't be seen

Create a 'Platinum Jubilee of the Queen' design to be printed on mugs. Please draw your bold and colourful design on a piece of A5 paper (landscape) and hand it in to the school office before Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> May.

Create your own shadow puppets and make up a story to perform with them.

Time yourself doing a physical challenge (for example, run around your garden, do 20 burpees...) 5 separate times. Record your times and compare them. Perhaps you could persuade a family member to join you so that you can compare with their times too :)

Create a video or write a letter to persuade your teachers that we should have a 'bring your pet to school' day (or another special day with a theme of your choice).

While we are introducing a new spelling programme at Standlake School, spellings will be a little different. This term the children in Blake Class have personalised spellings lists, based on their own 'tricky' words. You will find these in their Home Learning books.
