

Foundation Stage Unit Termly Planning

Understanding the World:

We will be learning:

- We will be looking carefully at ourselves and the things that make us special.
- We will also look at whom and what is important to us.
- The names of parts of our bodies and how we can look after our bodies through food and exercise.
- How things change over time including people and the world around us.

RE: Our big question this term is: What makes people special? We will be discussing our friends, family, role models. We will also be looking at Jesus and Moses and the ten commandments.

PSED: We will be using Jigsaw to look at Being Me. We will discuss our emotions and feelings and ways in which we can express ourselves. We will also create class rules and understand how we are responsible for our choices.

Communication and Language/Literacy: This term we will be looking at the key texts; Funny bones, Titch and the Growing Story. We will be learning to join in with repeated phrases as well as spot the rhyming words. We will develop our listening skills and recall skills through story times. In phonics, we will be working on our segmenting and blending skills as well as developing our alliteration and rhyme skills.

Marvellous Me!



This term our topic is Marvellous Me! We will be learning about friendships, our bodies and building relationships as we start our learning journey in Murphy Class.

Physical Development: This term we will be developing our gross motor skills through balancing games, obstacle course and exploring how exercise has an impact on our bodies. We will also be developing our fine motor skills through the use of loose parts, tweezers and playdough to create portraits and representations of our emotions.

Maths: We will be learning to:

- Count forwards and backwards using touch counting.
- Understand the numbers 0-5 using number blocks.
- Match and sort objects
- Comparing groups of objects focussing on quantity.
- Explore patterns.

Expressive Arts: We will be learning to:

- Create a self-portrait using simple materials
- Draw a friend using basic shapes.
- Using a variety of materials to create representations of emotions.
- Explore listening games and develop our listening skills.
- Begin to explore rhythm by singing nursery rhymes.
