English We will be learning to:

Science We will be learning to:

- > Explore the senses on a sensory walk and describe each sense
- > Look after our bodies through hygiene and healthy eating

RE We will be learning to:

- ➤ Key Question: 'Does God want Christians to look after the world?'
- > Dramatise the Creation story and order pictures of the story
- Express an opinion about the Creation story

Geography We will be learning to:

- Look at different types of maps and draw streets from an aerial view
- Discuss vocabulary: country, city, town, street
- Explore different jobs around the world
