YOUNG VOICES: REMINDER

This is for all children in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6. It is being held in Birmingham Resorts World Arena on **Wednesday 18th May (NEXT WEEK)**. If you have ordered tickets to come and watch, they will be sent home with the children today (Thursday). We will also be distributing the pre-ordered t-shirts and packs to the children over the next week. Please could the 24 families who have not yet paid do so, otherwise the school will make a £480 loss on this trip. If cost is a problem, please contact the school office.

Children need to bring the following:

- A packed lunch (to eat on the way there). *You can order school packed lunch on the day.*
- A packed tea (to eat in-between rehearsals)
- A rucksack to carry their food, drink and school jumper
- Children come dressed in school uniform and need to be wearing a white polo shirt or t-shirt

Children will come into school at the normal time and will have a morning of normal lessons. We will be leaving at midday so that we arrive by 1.30pm for rehearsals. The afternoon will be spent rehearsing with 2000+ other children, having 'tea' in the resort and then starting the concert at 7.00pm. The concert will finish at 8.45pm and we are aiming to be back at 10.30pm.

All children must be in school the next day. However, due to the late arrival home, we are happy for families to drop their children off in the morning a little later, but all children must be in school by 10.00am on Thursday. You can still drop your children off at the normal time.

We are all VERY excited about taking the children to the Young Voices concert because it is an experience they will never forget!
